HDNA COVID-19 Attendance Registrar

- All players, coaches, managers, umpires, spectators, volunteers, visitors must **SCAN IN** on arrival at the courts and **SCAN OUT** on departure
- QR Code posters with instructions easily accessible around the venue
- Paper copy of Attendance Registrar also available on the score sheets



Spectators/Parents/Visitors/Volunteers

- Maintain physical distancing of 1.5 metres from other people
- Avoid unnecessary socialising/co-mingling before and after games
- Where possible keep moving to avoid gatherings
- Get in, enjoy the game, get out!



Players/Umpires/Coaches/Managers

- No handshakes, no high fives, no cuddling
- Do not share drink bottles or hand towels
- Bubblers to be used for filling up drink bottles only
- Avoid unnecessary socialising/co-mingling before and after games
- Get in, play, get out!

- Avoid touching your face
- Sanitise/wash your hands regularly
